

What is Apprenticeship Randolph?



Apprenticeship Randolph is Randolph County's premier opportunity for students to get a jump start on a professional career in our booming local industries. Students have the opportunity to maximize earning potential, gain valuable skills and experience through on-the-job training, and earn an Associate of Applied Science degree in Manufacturing Technology from Randolph Community College at no cost to the student.

The apprenticeship program is a partnership between industry, student, parent, and Randolph County Schools which provides on-the-job training while a student completes their high school education. The program extends two to four years in a comprehensive Work Process for the apprentice. High school juniors and seniors are eligible to participate and the program is sanctioned by the NC Department of Commerce allowing students under 18 to work in industrial setting in work-based learning program.
